MOTION A:

That Current Practice 2014.05 a (Effective January 2015, Trusted Servants of District 8 will only be eligible to hold one voting position at a time at the district level.) be rescinded immediately and be replaced by a new Current Practice:

“Effective March 2021, Trusted Servants of District 8 are eligible to hold up to 2 voting positions at a time at the district level but will be limited to 1 vote if so serving, with the following 2 exceptions: 1) Officers of District 8 are not eligible to hold more than 1 voting position; and, 2) DCMs and ACMs are not eligible to also serve as a GSR or alternate GSR.”

BACKGROUND:

Regardless of its intent Current Practice 2014.05 a has had the effect of limiting qualified Trusted Servants from serving in more than one voting position when doing so may be for the good of the District.

ACCESSIBILITIES: accessibilities@district8area15.org

I attended the Area quarterly on zoom in January. Melissa L. is our new Accessibility Chair. Ashley O. from District 8 is our new Secretary and voted in as Alternate Chair and Treasurer. Three other districts attended. Tom W., our Delegate for the Area stopped in and informed us he is on the Accessibility Committee for the General Service Conference. They will be reviewing the Accessibility Workbook. The agenda will also be "Barriers to Access" and perhaps virtual meetings. Tom offered he is available to speak at our district meeting.

We discussed how AA has ways to carry the message to people with reading disabilities. Our BB, 12 and 12 and other books come on DVD with ASL interpreter and captions, audible books, braille and large print. We discussed a new business what we will be focusing on. Ideas that explore barriers to access that deter carrying the message of AA. This may be people with reading disabilities, visual difficulty in a meeting, hearing impaired or simply getting to meeting. Some solutions should be sitting in a circle so people can read lips wheelchair access virtual meetings and childcare. Where and When's could list if there's wheelchair access. We examined the possibility of collaborating with PICPC and Remote Communities. Mary from District 5 is hearing impaired and related that sometimes the spirit of AA is hard to convey.

I did an inventory of what we have for display and in stock. 20, printed copies of the serenity prayer in sign. ASL DVD from Florida state convention of speakers. Assorted assisted listening devices and equipment. Three 4th edition Big Book in braille. Four FAQs in braille. Thirteen This is AA, An introduction to the AA Recovery Program in braille. Eight Is AA For You? In braille. We I have many pamphlets, Is AA for you and AA for the Alcoholic with Special Needs. I also brought the Accessibility Workbook from General Service and will be reviewing that.

An email went out from General Service that they want stories A.A. for the Older Alcoholic for audio recordings.

As I've been going through all of this for the first time my heart feels full of gratitude for the huge amount of work, patience and love that goes into carrying the message of AA.

Good afternoon folks, there is quite a bit of work to be done in order to organize our Archives. We need many volunteers that are computer and organizational savvy. I have over 500 speakers in Alcoholics Anonymous. Some are speeches from the early members of alcoholics anonymous. Original recorded talks by Bill Wilson, Doctor Bob, Bill Dobson, etc. Some are members who are local but got sober in the 50s 60s and 70s. Most of these are deceased. In addition I have hundreds from conferences of over the 30 years that I've been sober. Some of these talks in .mp3 were made before I got sober. They need to be organized and put on our website so that people can access them. I said 500, it could be 1000. Each day that we wait we could be helping people who cannot get out to meetings. So, the bottom line, I need help. maybe meet at either Starbucks or Dunkin' Donuts, at a time that works for all. Maybe a Saturday afternoon, possibly 2 PM or Sunday afternoon, 2 PM? Would appreciate help from anyone. Andy D. said he would meet this next weekend. In addition, after organizing these would like to post these to a place on our website. Possibly charge for them. 1 dollar for each download. As it is quite a bit of work to put these there and would go to a good cause, The preservation of our history. Not that we pay members for our time but we do incur costs to preserve the items we hold dear. Also, to know that these talks are some the best in our fellowship. Culled by active long-term members in our fellowship. Welcome to all the new General Service members for your groups.

We also have our documents. Some movies. Many reports. Books, pamphlets, and articles that are either needing to be digitized or already are. Some conference approved, some not. But need to be organized. Determination of what is to be uploaded to our website. In addition, will have to see about our next quarterly. Want to attend but not sure I can due to work. Will ask a home group member to attend or a volunteer and give my report.

Have continued to send out the conference approved messages, thought for the day (TFD) from Reflections published first printed in 1990 two years after I got sober. (We used the 24 hour a day book from Hazelden in my group til recent years) and Grapevine TFD which started about 2 years ago. I send it out to those who wish each day via email and text. Let me know if you are interested. Grapevine started in 1944.

Today, and in this month, significant in AA History: on this day, February 21 1939 – 400 copies of the Big Book manuscript were sent to doctors, judges, psychiatrists, and others for comment. This was the “multilith” Big Book. Of more Note this month in our collective history: February 2

1942 – Bill W. paid tribute to Ruth Hock, AA's first paid secretary, who resigned to get married. She had written approximately 15,000 letters to people asking for help

February 22

1842 – Abe Lincoln addressed the Washington Temperance Society in Springfield, IL. The speech available upon r++ Equest.

In preparation for this effort, the committee will review the publications and service guidelines posted on the *GVR Resources* page (<https://www.aagrapevine.org/gvr-resources>). After an inventory of supplies remaining from the Panel 69 committee, I will order enough GVR kits for committee members to use in our presentations to the AA groups.

The committee also discussed plans for the next Grapevine workshop, which we expect to be held virtually. We agreed to bring content and theme ideas to our next meeting, which will be at 3:00 PM on March 14, 2021 – immediately prior to the district business meeting. I'm Joanna, alcoholic, and chair of your Public Information and Cooperation with the Professional Community committee. First, I want to congratulate our own Nancy C, my predecessor in this committee, for becoming the new Area 15 PICPC Secretary/Treasurer. Nancy continues to help our committee in special ways.

The biggest item in the Conference Agenda for Public Information is creation of a podcast. The Trustees' PI committee has been doing a lot of research on the logistics and sustainability of this project over the last year. There is a lot of AA related stuff on podcast already out there, but "AAWS and GSO are in a unique position to share insights into the service structure." Topics or themes to consider include Interviews with Trustees, a recurring Archives show with the GSO Archivist, Box 459 "live," and AA around the World. PI is also considering revising the pamphlet "Speaking at Non-AA Meetings," probably to include a section on media training and press interviews in accordance with our public relations policy (Tradition 11). "The goal is to retain as much information from the current pamphlet as possible, add vital information and useful material, re-organize, and condense."

The main Cooperation with the Professional Community item is to create a pamphlet for Mental Health Professionals. The main objective is to dispel misconceptions and misinformation about AA, and the idea is that a pamphlet specifically addressed to their profession will increase the likelihood of them actually reading it.

As for the last Area 15 Assembly, I listened very closely to what the other districts are doing for any ideas that could be helpful to our committee. I have since made connections with trusted servants from other districts who have a lot of experience with various projects. I sat in on a presentation to med school students by District 4 and I attended their monthly committee meeting. Our committee has plans for a number of projects, but I will leave them for future reports.

We also got pamphlets out to a few food banks. Most are actually churches, and some ask for pamphlets in Spanish, which we are now able to give them.
